

Modern Slavery Act 2015

In compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015, Archwood Ltd offers the following statement regarding its efforts to prevent slavery and human trafficking in its supply chain.

Policy relating to Modern Slavery within the whole organisation

Archwood Ltd is committed to social and environmental responsibility and has zero tolerance for slavery and human trafficking. We hold ourselves and our supply chain accountable in ensuring that both we and our suppliers comply with the provisions of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

We recognise that modern slavery is a complex supply chain issue, and we work in partnership with our customers, suppliers both in the UK and abroad, to help develop long-term solutions to this issue.

Training

The purchasing team are trained and very experienced in the procurement of goods. As a result we have a well-established supplier base that conforms to our “working with” criteria which includes risk mitigation regarding Modern Slavery. The team have been briefed on the requirements of this legislation and continue to work in conjunction with the supplier base to identify and action issues relating to it.

The Human resources department are trained and work to all UK legislation and include mitigation within company policy.

Supply Chain Management

The purchasing team has a zero tolerance against modern slavery practices within the supply chain and conduct onsite supplier audits which review all aspects of the supply chain including safety, human trafficking, child labour and other legal requirements. Where required we will also use third party auditors if a potential risk is highlighted.
